

CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL

- Guides over all workforce development priorities for local areas

- Planning and implementation
- Advise on economic conditions of local area
- Fiscal and program oversight and monitoring
- Select vendor(s) to deliver services
- Negotiate local performance



LWIB REQUIRED MEMBERS

- 51% from the business community
- Labor unions
- Community based organizations
- Education (public schools and community colleges)
- Economic development
- Other core One-Stop partners
